What do we do in Pedmore?

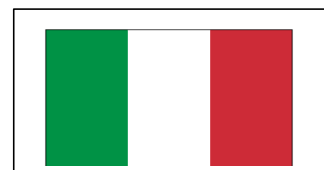
We endeavour to put a Christian Aid envelope into every letterbox in Pedmore and a few days later knock on each door in order to give all the people of Pedmore a chance to donate.
