We affirm our faith

We proclaim the Church's faith in Jesus Christ.

**All: We believe and declare that our Lord Jesus Christ, the Son
of God, is both divine and human.**

God, of the being of the Father,

**All: fully God and fully human;
human in both mind and body.**

As God he is equal to the Father,

**All: Although he is both divine and human
he is not two beings but one Christ.**
